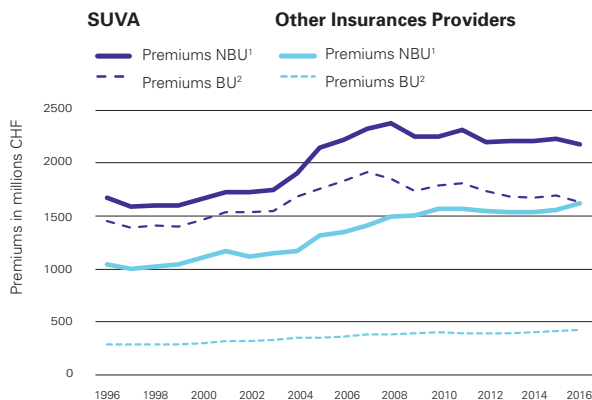

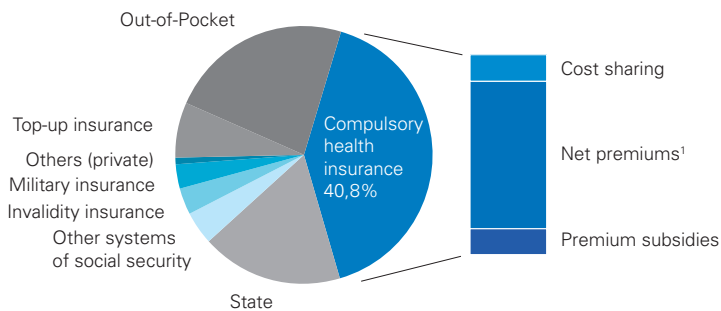

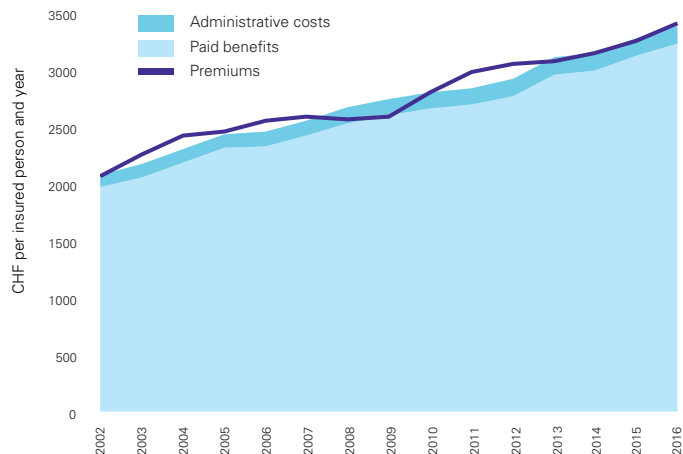
(POV health insurance premiums)

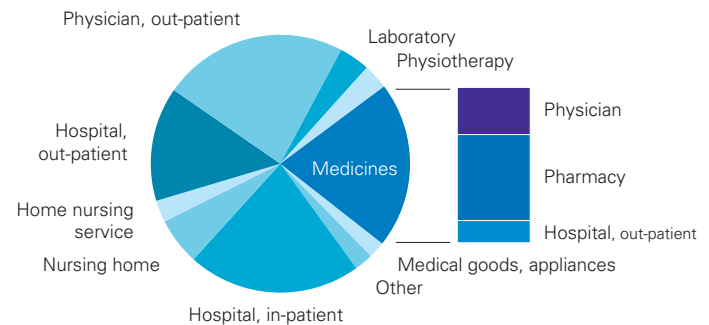
